

## Szabad Média Pályázat [Free Media Grant Program] ANNOUNCEMENT OF RESULTS

Following approval by the US Embassy in Budapest, the decision on the applications received for the 3rd call for proposals has been made by Mérték Media Monitor and the Ökotárs Foundation.

A total of 42 applications were received by the deadline. Of these, 36 applications were submitted for "strengthening and improving the sustainability of local and national independent public media" (category A) and 6 for "implementing media literacy and education and journalism training programmes" (category B).

Based on the decision of the Embassy of the United States of America, the following 26 applications (22 category A, 4 category B) were awarded grants for a total amount of **173 178 230 HUF**:
